

### Letter of Attestation

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Larimer County Childcare Scholarship. To be eligible to receive a scholarship for children ages 6-12, families must meet the criteria as outlined below.

By signing below, I attest to the following:

- The family/parent/guardian is [I am] a Larimer County resident with children ages 6-12 (not eligible for K-12 education due to age);
- The family/parent/guardian is [I am] impacted by the absence of in-person school during working hours;
- The family/parent/guardian is [I am] seeking care from a licensed childcare provider, Neighborhood Youth Organization, or nonprofit community organization located in Larimer County;
- The family/parent/guardian [My] household income is less than the most recently published self-sufficiency wage for Larimer County ([2020 Self-Sufficiency Standards by County](#)).
  - The Self-Sufficiency Standard determines the amount of income required for working families to meet basic needs at a minimally adequate level, taking into account family composition, ages of children, and geographic differences in costs.
